Gregory Treverton-Jones QC joined 39 Essex Street in September 2006. He specialises in regulatory and disciplinary law, with a particular emphasis on the solicitors' profession, and has acted for the Law Society and Respondent solicitors since the early 1990s. He has appeared in many of the leading cases in this area, including *Bultitude v The Law Society* [2004] EWCA Civ 1853; *Sritharan v The Law Society* [2005] 1 WLR 2708 ; *Sheikh v The Law Society* [2006] EWCA 1577, and, most recently, *The Law Society v Adcock and Mocroft* [2006] EWHC 3212 (Admin). He is co-author with Andrew Hopper QC of the *Solicitor's Handbook 2008*, and the recently published 2009 edition

Andrew Hopper QC is a solicitor Silk, still a rare species; he was the fifth solicitor advocate to be appointed Silk and the first outside the City of London. He has specialised in the field of professional regulation and discipline, principally of solicitors but also of other professionals, for 30 years. He has been described in *Chambers* as "the oracle of all things relating to solicitors' disciplinary proceedings". He is co-author with Gregory Treverton-Jones QC of the *Solicitor's Handbook 2008*, and the recently published 2009 edition. He is an editor of *Cordery on Solicitors*, was an editor of the last edition of the *Law Society's Guide to Professional Conduct*, is a consultant editor to *Halsbury's Laws of England*, a contributor to *Butterworths Guide to the Legal Services Act 2007*, and the cases editor of the *Legal Compliance Bulletin*. He has recently been appointed to the *Regulatory Affairs Board of the Law Society*.
