## Inquiries and Investigations

Eleanor has superb experience in the field of Public Inquiries and non-statutory investigations, particularly in the healthcare sector.

She started her practice in this area in 1999 as Junior Counsel to the Bristol Royal Infirmary Public Inquiry. She has since acted as Counsel to the Inquiry in other, as well representing Core Participants in the Hutton Inquiry (where she acted for the House of Commons), the Mid-Staffordshire Public Inquiry (for the Healthcare Commission) and the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse (both for the Labour Party and a group of schools). She is currently leading the Counsel team for the Department of Health and Social Care in the Infected Blood Inquiry, as well as gearing up for the Covid-19 Public Inquiry, in which she represents NHS England.

Eleanor has a keen interest in non-statutory investigations. She chaired a Review of the Disclosure and Barring Service's barring functions, and a further investigation into paediatric cardiac surgery in Bristol.

She has carried out private investigations into other challenging situations, including in disciplinary matters.
