

She is regularly instructed in commercial disputes between service providers and local authorities. Recent work includes advising on a series of PFI contracts for waste disposal services, acting for an economic operator in a procurement challenge to a contract for provision of youth services, and acting for the Secretary of State for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities (formerly MHCLG) in a high-

profile application to the High Court concerning whether local authorities could continue to hold meetings remotely once emergency coronavirus legislation expired.
